




Zambia Economic Growth 2001-2015

Between 2001 and 2015 economic growth rates in Zambia fluctuated, but generally increased from **5-6.5%. The average growth rate was **5.6%**. **2002** saw the lowest growth (**3%**) and **2010** the highest (**7%**)**
